Post Conference Tour A: 6. – 10. September 2010

(Einsiedeln – Lucerne – Interlaken – Berne – Gruyère – Lausanne)

Monday 6. September 2010

Departure by bus and stopover in Einsiedeln. Visit the famous baroque monastery church. Continue to beautiful Lucerne and enjoy on a guided city tour the walk over the old Kapell Bridge which is crossing the outflow of the Lake Lucerne. Cross the Alpine Bruenig Pass and arrive in Interlaken at the foot of the impressive mountains of the Bernese Oberland. Overnight stay at Hotel Metropole.



Tuesday 7. September 2010

Go on excursion and follow the tracks of James Bond by being taken up to Mount Gloria (Schilthorn). While lunching you may almost touch the well known peaks Eiger, Moench and Jungfrau. In the afternoon you are free to discover Interlaken and enjoy shopping. The evening will include musical entertainment.



Wednesday 8. September 2010

On the road again to Berne, the Swiss capital. Stroll on a guided tour through its charming picturesque old town. The tour will continue to Gruyère, the well known cheese making area. Visit a cheese dairy and taste "meringues", the local speciality. Accommodation at the country architecture style Hotel Cailler in Charmey. Relax in the pool area and make use of the wellness opportunities.



Thursday 9. September 2010

The tour takes you to the world cultural heritage area of Lake Geneva. Enjoy a boat trip with lunch and visit the Chillon Castle as well as the Olympic Museum in Lausanne. Return back to the Gruyère area and farewell-dinner for the tour finishers.

Friday 10. September 2010

Departure for Zurich (arrival Zurich Airport 11.00 h) or continuation tour B by bus to Zermatt.

Transfer by bus to Zermatt, the resort at the foot of the world known Matterhorn. Afternoon-walk. Accommodation at Hotel Antares.

Saturday 11. September 2010

Excursion by train to Gornergrat where one has the exciting view of the Matterhorn. Those who want to experience hiking walk down to Zermatt. Evening: Farewell dinner with folklore presentations.



Sunday 12. September 2010

Transfer back to Zurich Airport (Arrival 13.00 h)
